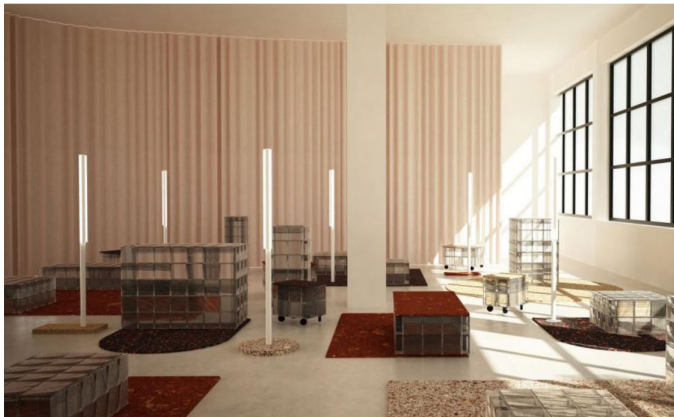


Top 5 studios to look out for at Collective Design Fair in New York
