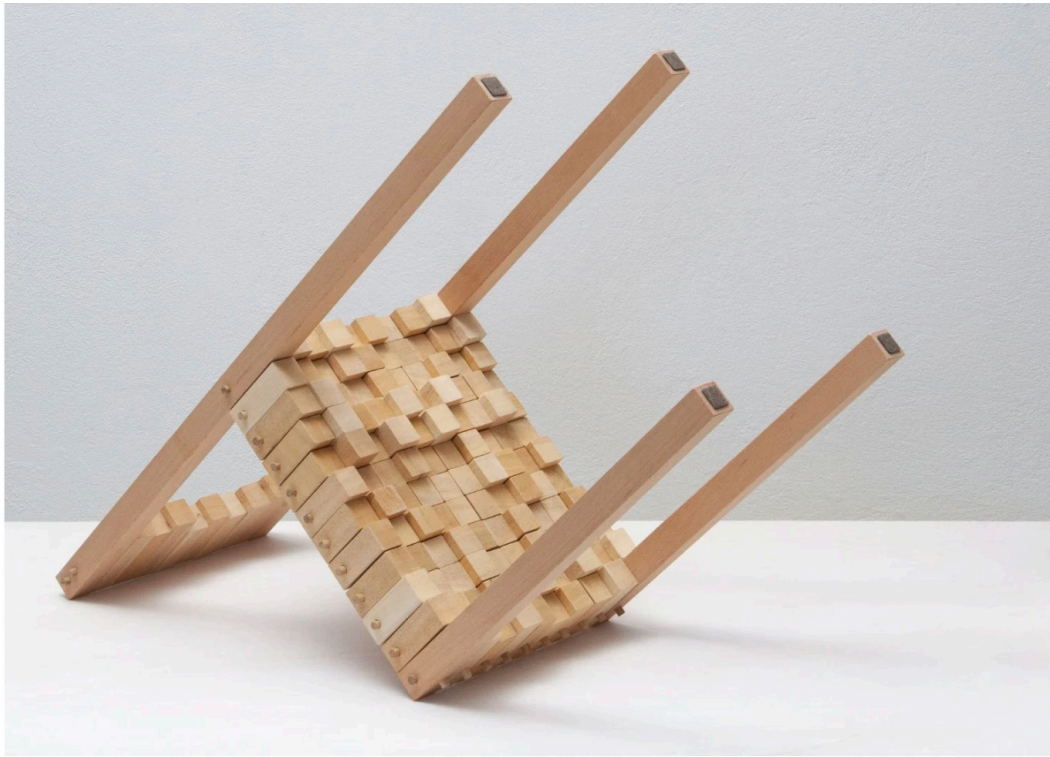

With an optimistic outlook on the future, the designers invite visitors to interact with a fascinating sensory landscape – as one walks through three inflatable oversized PVC tubes, each viewer has a personal experience of space and time as well as presence and absence.

In "Homecoming", on the other hand, Erez Nevi Pana envisions a futuristic panorama of humans, animals and nature living harmoniously on the Earth, which must be protected and preserved.

Inspired by astronaut Neil Armstrong, Pana invites one to look at the Earth from above and his eclectic setting includes – a pool of water as a metaphor for the life force, a landing pad for imaginary spaceships and a flag effortlessly symbolizing the vision of the living Earth as a coherent unit.
